

Our spring 2010 retreat will be held at the Harbor View Hotel & Resort on Martha's Vineyard from Tuesday, May 18, 2010 through Friday, May 21, 2010. The resort offers 114 casually-sophisticated, well appointed guest rooms. This trip promises to be great fun. Invite your friends to join you, or gather a group together.



Depart from Woods Hole at the Steamship Authority the morning of May 18, and arrive in time for lunch and class, which begins at 1PM. Fare for the ferry is \$15.00, round trip. Transportation around the island is provided by Vineyard Transportation Authority (VTA), cab or bicycles, which can be rented. If you are travelling by car, a reservation must be made EARLY to assure a place. Wait-listing your vehicle is encouraged, if there is currently no space. Charge for a car under 17' in length is \$85.00; over 17' in length is \$105.00. Fares are round trip.

This spring's knitting project is the "Project of your Choice". Learn the tricks and tips of a custom fit sweater. Suggestions include: a Vivian Hoxbro sweater or vest; a Harrisville sweater knit in Highland or Orchid (www.harrisvilledesign.com); a Green Mountain Spinnery selection such as the Stars and Bars cardigan in Cotton Comfort; Rosemary's sweater in Mountain Mohair (www.spinnery.com) or a cable (Fisherman's) pullover.

Hotel package rate (double occupancy) is \$429.50 per person. Single occupancy is \$683.00 per person. Rates include 2 Continental Breakfasts (Wednesday and Thursday), 2 deli buffet luncheons (Wednesday and Thursday), and 2 gourmet dinners (Tuesday and Wednesday). Tuesday's lunch and Thursday's dinner are not included. Please add MA room tax at 9.7% and gratuity. Please make your initial reservation with the yarn shop. Once spaces are filled and confirmed, you may make your reservation with the hotel by calling 800-225-6005. Be certain to mention that you are with the knitting retreat. Hotel reservations must be made by Sunday, April 18, 2010. Be certain to inquire about the hotel's sliding scale of cancellation penalties.

Lamb's Ear Yarns' fee is \$275.00 plus the cost of the sweater you choose. Supplemental lighting and personal supplies are recommended. Evenings are unscheduled, but you are free to spend the evening knitting, as Donna will be available for help. Or, you can explore on your own.

Reservations, non-refundable deposits of \$150.00, sweater selections and yarn colors must be made by April 1, 2010. Send the deposit and the signed acknowledgement below to the following: Lamb's Ear Yarns, 3 Waterford Place, Gilford, New Hampshire 03249-6661. Balance to Lamb's Ear Yarns is due by April 18, 2010. Checks or cash are preferred.
